

HEALTH & SAFETY / CONSTRUCTION, DESIGN & MANAGEMENT REGULATIONS

The Organisers of The Commercial Vehicle Show 2017 take Health & Safety and the rules that are imposed on them under Construction; Design & Management Regulations seriously. As Principle Contractor on the site, the Organisers require the following actions to be followed.

- High visibility vests / jackets shall be worn at all times within the halls and around the loading / unloading areas immediately outside the access doors.
- Contractor Badges must be worn and be visible at all times.
- Appropriate footwear must be worn at all times. Open toed shoes or flat ballet type shoes (sandals for example) etc. will not be permitted to worn in the halls during the build-up and breakdown phases of this event.
- Hard hats must be worn in areas of high construction or as directed by the event Health & Safety Manager.
- Emergency Gangways must not be blocked by stand construction materials / vehicles or exhibits.
- Contractors / Exhibitors are responsible for keeping their stand space, and the immediate area around it, in a safe condition.
- Speed limits with the site shall be adhered to.
- No children under the age of 16 years are permitted on site at any time. This includes in the cabs of vehicles.
